- We serve 50 students in grades 9-12 each year.
- The Explorers Program is a year-round, 3 to 4-year program.

# HOW TO APPLY

**Must be a rising freshman, a rising sophomore, or a rising junior.**

- Must attend a Newark school or reside in Newark
- Minimum GPA of 2.7
- One (1) teacher recommendation letter
- Current grades
- Completed short response and essay

All applications undergo an extensive review process. Once selected, applicants will be interviewed between July - August. If accepted, students participate in a 3-day orientation in October.
